Training Details

The Cemeteries and Crematoria Association of South Australia has been successful in receiving a funding grant through Service Skills SA "Industry Skills development Grant" in the amount of \$15,000, to subsidise the cost of offering an accredited Cemetery Safety course to CCASA members, promoting safe working practices in cemeteries.

- Soil Conditions and Shoring Requirements: Considerations for Different Soil Types / Shoring Requirements and Options, Pros and Cons of Different Equipment
- Trench Collapse and Consolidation: Management of a Collapse
- Exhumation: Regulations and Requirements / Biological Hazards and Controls
- Mausoleum: Preparing and Reinstating Vaults or Crypts / Regulations and Requirements
- Dealing with Grief in the Workplace: Techniques for Dealing with People with Mental Health Issues / Techniques for Dealing with People Affected by Alcohol or Drugs in the Workplace
- Legislation: Employer and Employee Responsibilities / Best practice for Following Work Health and Safety Procedures / Risk Assessments
- Working in Confined Spaces: Is the Space a Confined Space? / Regulations and Requirements
